**(PROPOSED) ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS'
MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

This case comes before the Court on Plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment. For the reasons set forth in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, it is hereby

ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment (Dkt. No. __) is GRANTED;
and it is further

ORDERED that the failure of the Federal Election Commission (FEC) to find "reason to believe" that Crossroads GPS violated the Federal Election Campaign Act and the FEC's subsequent dismissal of Plaintiffs' administrative complaint is declared arbitrary, capricious, an abuse of discretion and otherwise contrary to law; and it is further

ORDERED that the Commission shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, conform with this declaration consistent with the accompanying Memorandum Opinion.
